As the founder of OneMama.org, SER Consulting (a Fortune 500 technology consulting company), and Fighting for Your JOY, Siobhan is dedicated to being a catalyst for positive global social change.

As an organizational staffing consultant for large companies such as Amazon, Google, and Visa, Siobhan builds the teams these global corporations need to be a success. Currently, working with Amazon, she is responsible for recruiting in the latest emerging technologies, with diversity, inclusion, and STEM as her lead hiring focuses.

Siobhan has now translated for-profit Fortune 500 core methodologies into building an international non-profit organization--OneMama.org. OneMama is a self-sustaining health clinic in Uganda that promotes safe birthing environments, family and financial planning, as well as entrepreneurial tradecrafts, services, and agricultural education. Siobhan set out to create self-sustainable communities around the world after overcoming her own obstacles of illness, poverty, and the loss of her child. OneMama was created in an effort to help the world render strife into peace, empowering all women to have a voice in the same way that she found hers.

Siobhan's philosophies are at the very core of social entrepreneurialism, and are just a small example of the immense potential each individual has for creating a global economy with JOY as its currency. The "Fighting for your JOY!" book and movement reveal a glimpse behind the business and personal techniques necessary to live purposefully, while harnessing your talents to create global change with JOY!

Siobhan served as an NGO delegate to the United Nations from CSW sessions 59 through now, and the OneMama organization has official consultative DPI and ECOSOC status allowing us to bring our own delegates to this global stage.

Mrs. Bineta Diop is a multilingual public speaker, interfaith activist, and a child's advocate. As the founder of the SAMATATA Foundation, a nonprofit organization that believes that all children should have adequate upbringing stressed by quality access to education, Bineta hopes to reach into the deepest corners of the world and promote her STOP THREE CAMPAIGN: child labor, female genital mutilation, and child begging. Her dream is to empower women and children for a silent revolution of the family environment in developing countries.



Bineta has been involved with child welfare programs here in the U.S. and in Senegal, West Africa, including work with local lawmakers set out to eradicate the old practice of child beggars and female genital cutting. She recuperated pan handling kids from the streets and worked in reuniting them with their families while setting up a safe environment for the continuation of their education. She is a Founding member of Naylor Maaram Senegal, an organization that assists foster kids and provides basics hygienic materials and food to the impoverished village children ages 5 to 18 years old.

Bineta participated at the United Nations CSW 56 until now representing Women's Intercultural Network (WIN) and the OneMama organization. Bineta is currently the CEO of JTBS, an international Paralegal and Translation Company. She attended the World Peace Assembly and Signed the ratification for world peace for the children submitted to the United Nations in 2008.
